

Mark Latham and Georgia Aston-Massey both celebrated a cleansweep of victories at the final round of the West Cheshire AC Schools Cross Country Race Series.

Mark, representing Eaton, claimed the year six boys title by clocking his fastest time of four minutes 57 seconds for the flat course at Stanney Oaks, beating runner-up Billy Young (Helsby Hillside) who posted 5:18, and third placed Elijah Montez-Brown (St Saviours) who finished in 5:27.

Georgia Aston-Massey, from Hornsmill, secured her fourth consecutive win in the year six girls event with her fastest time of the series - five minutes 10 seconds.

Georgia Barlow (St Bernards) captured second spot at the final round race with a time of 5:52 to secure runners-up position overall, and Cora Finlay (St Saviours) finished third at the final round, while Eden Richardson (Capenhurst), who was seventh at round four, claimed third place overall.

The Acresfield trio of Anna Todd, Stella Dixon, and Isabel Clements won the year six girls team title.

Tarporley High's Amy Hinchly won the year seven girls title with a winning time of 8:52 at the final round, with Helsby's Megan McEveley second in 9:05. Natasha Tudor (Kings Chester) claimed runners-up position overall.

Jessica Thomas, from Farndon, won the year five girls gold medal after winning the final round race in a time of 5:36, from runner-up overall, Charlotte King (Helsby Hillside), and third-placed Esther Wilson (Hornsmill).

Heather Mylchreest (Acresfield) clinched the year four girls title despite finishing second at the final round with a time of 3:37, behind round four winner, Emma Hodgson (Eaton) who finished third overall. Beth McMahon (Millview) finished third at the fourth round and clinched runners-up position overall.

Gabriella Tugulea, from Newton, strided her way to success in the year three girls event overall and at the final round with a time of 3:36.

Kate Mansfield, also of Newton, finished second on the day with 3:49 to claim runners-up position overall, and Ciara Bolt-Wilson (Eaton) finished third overall, while Emily Riddick (Newton) was third at the final round.

The trio of Gabriella Tugulea, Kate Mansfield, and Emily Riddick combined to earn Newton the year three girls team title.

Tom Millburn, of Bishop Heber, had claimed the overall year seven boys title after winning the first three races.

The year seven final round was won by Oliver Thomas (Neston High) in a time of 8:28 to secure runners-up spot overall, while Chris Harrop (Tarporley), who finished second at the final round, secured third spot overall, and Daniel McCabe (Neston) finished third at the final round.

Tom Millburn, Zac Holland, and Tom Wright ensured Bishop Heber claimed the year seven boys team title. Joseph Morrison (Our Lady's) won the year five boys final race in 5:24 and claimed the overall individual gold medal, ahead of Josh Hinchly (Tarvin) who was second on the day and second overall, and Acresfield's Matthew Gamer who was third on the day and third overall.

Sonny Dean (Helsby Hillside) won the year three boys title after winning the final round race in a time of three minutes 15 seconds. He finished ahead of runner-up overall, Paul Morrison (Our Lady's), and third placed Ben Young (Eaton).

Farndon duo Louis Realf and Jack Wright finished first and second overall in the year four boys event, ahead of third placed Jac Goodall (Mickle Trafford).
